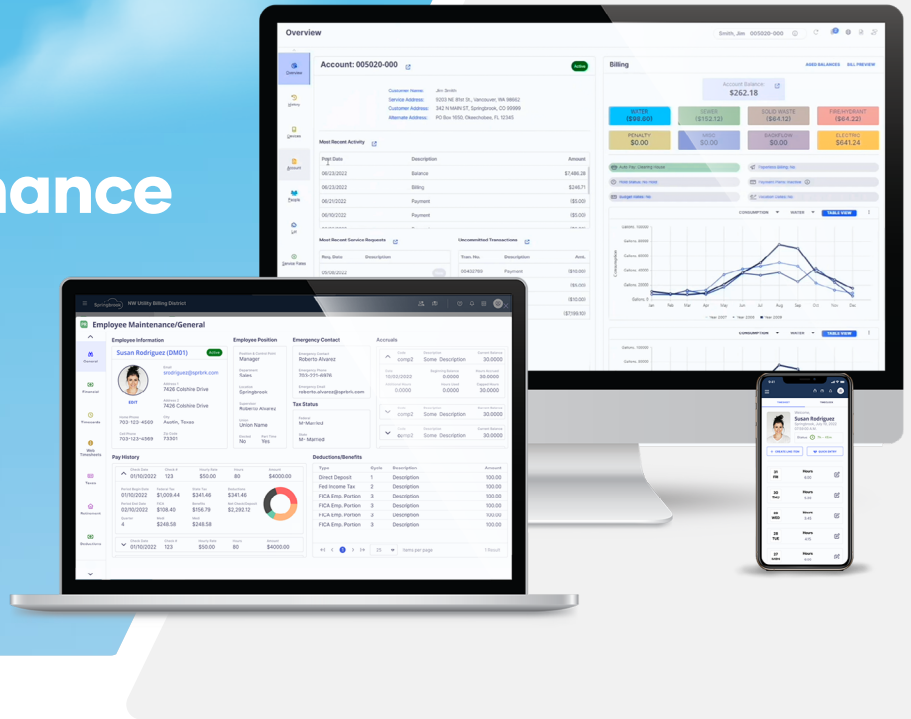
## Distributed Work Models
